RESOLUTION NO. 40

A RESOLUTION INDORSING WITH FULL SUPPORT RESOLUTION NO. 42 SERIES OF 1989 OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ORMOG, EXPRESSING FULL SUPPORT TO SENATE BILL NO. 950 WHICH SEEKS TO LIBERALIZE THE IMPORTATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY LOWERING THE TARIFF SO THAT THE PRICE OF CARS BE WITHIN THE REACH OF THE AVERAGE WORKERS AND ALSO TO RESTRUCTURE THE BOARD OF INVESTMENTS WHICH HAS BEEN OVERLY PROTECTIVE TO ONLY TWO (2) AUTHORIZED CAR ASSEMBLERS IN THE PHILIPPINES.

WHEREAS, for the purpose of enlisting support, the City Council of Ormog has furnished this august body its Resolution No. 42 dated February 21, 1989, expressing full support to Senate Bill No. 950 which seeks to liberalize the importation of motor vehicles by lowering the tariff so that the price of cars can be within the reach of the average workers and also to restructure the Board of Investments which has been overly protective to only two (2) authorized car assemblers in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, this august body conforms to the embodiment of said Resolution No. 42 of the City Council of Ormog and, believes as valid and very meritorious the purposes of Senate Bill No. 950;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Eufrocino C. Codilla, Jr., duly seconded by aye Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrasterza, Jr. and Celso P. Portadilla; be it

RESOLVED, to favorably indorse with full support Resolution No. 42, S. 1989 of the City Council of Ormog, and do as this body hereby does, concur with the embodiment of said resolution in expressing full support of Senate Bill No. 950 which seeks to liberalize the importation of motor vehicles by lowering the tariff so that the price of cars can be within the reach of the average workers and also to restructure the Board of Investments which has been overly protective to only two (2) authorized car assemblers in the Philippines;

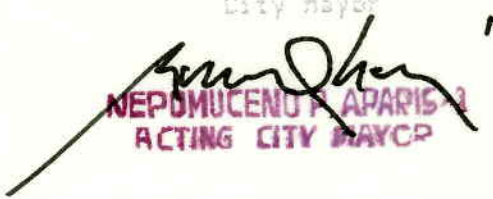
