RESOLUTION NO. 42

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY ADDRESSED TO THE HONORABLE SENATE PRESIDENT AND THE HONORABLE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, CONGRESS OF THE PHILIPPINES, HIGHLY REQUESTING FAVORABLE ACTION ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE PROVINCIAL/CITY POPULATION OFFICERS LEAGUE OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE INCLUSION OF THE PROVINCIAL/CITY POPULATION OFFICE AS A MANDATED REGULAR DEPARTMENT OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT AND THE INCORPORATION OF THE SAME IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE.

WHEREAS, the August body is in receipt of an indorsement letter from Honorable Ulberto E. Mata, City Mayor, Tacloban City and, attached thereto, a communication from the Provincial/City Population Officers League of the Philippines, requesting favorable indorsement of the recommendation of the said population officers league for the inclusion of the Provincial/City Population Office as a regular department of the local government unit and the incorporation of the same in the local government code, invoking, among others, that one major and basic problem causing the setback in the effective implementation of the project and smooth operation of the office is the ABSENCE OF A STRONG LEGAL MANDATE, the fact that the Provincial/City Population Office is not clearly defined in the local government code;

WHEREAS, according to the communication from the aforesaid Population Officers League that, after the local elections of 1987, a number of Population Offices throughout the country were abolished, a situation which heavily contributes to the insecurity of the existence of the office, the positions within, and the budgetary requirements thereof, all of which negatively affect the operation of the office;

WHEREAS, in Ormoc City, however, it is only by virtue of a local ordinance: Ordinance No. 8, s. 1977 of the First Sangguniang Bayan of Ormoc City that its City Population (or POPCOM) Office is made an office

on special services under the Office of the City Mayor, - a manifestation that the Local Government of Ormoc City has recognized the achievements and importance of the POPCOM Office in many local development projects and efforts;

WHEREAS, sending the views on all of the foregoing, this august Body believes that the request of the Provincial/City Population Officers League of the Philippines is reasonable and forthwith to give due course and favorable consideration;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Gregorio A. Vrasitoran, duly seconded by Kagawad Arnulfo C. Salazar, be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution respectfully addressed to Honorable Senate President Jovito Salonga and Honorable Speaker Ramon Mitra, House of Representatives, Congress of the Philippines, highly requesting favorable action on the recommendation of the Provincial/City Population Officers League of the Philippines for the inclusion of the Provincial/City Population Office as a mandated regular department of the local government unit and the incorporation of the same in the local government code;

ENACTED, March 30, 1989.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to Honorable Senate President Jovito Salonga, Senate, Congress of the Philippines, Manila; Honorable Speaker Ramon Mitra, House of Representatives, Congress of the Philippines, Quezon City; Honorable Carmelo J. Locsin, Congressman, 4th District, Leyte; the Provincial/City Population Officers League of the Philippines, Manila; and, Honorable Ma. Victoria L. Locsin, City Mayor, Ormoc City;
