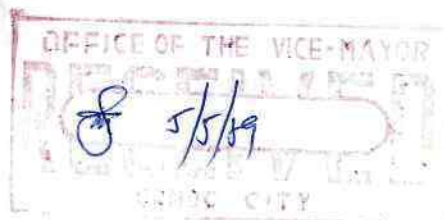

RESOLUTION NO. 59

A RESOLUTION OF CONDOLENCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY AND CLAN OF THE
LATE INP-STATION COMMANDER OF TACLOBAN CITY, POLICE MAJOR GABRIEL
SUDARIO BARDILLON.

WHEREAS, we have been deeply shocked over the sudden and untimely
death of a dearly loved and highly esteemed Police Major Gabriel Sudario
Bardillon, who succumbed in the afternoon last April 29, 1989;

WHEREAS, the late Gabriel Sudario Bardillon, who was borned and a
bonafide resident of Dagami, Leyte, had, according to very reliable
source, dedicated chapters of his best years in life to the people of
his hometown for whose common weal had been his primordial concern; a
self-made man whose sole aim was to serve his fellowmen;

WHEREAS, immediately before the transfer of Gabriel, (as he was
fondly called by closed friends), to Tacloban City as INP-Station
Commander of the said city, he had served Ormoc City with the same
position and responsibility as Station Commander of the Ormoc Integrated
National Police and, with his dedication, vision and commitment to his
job during his term of incumbency from 1986 to 1988, he had greatly
helped Ormoc City to its present status of a peaceful and beautiful
city;

WHEREAS, reckoning back to his service in the government of which
Gabriel had served for thirty two (32) long years, twenty (20) years of
which in police services, Police Major Gabriel S. Bardillon had the
following appointments: 1968 to 1974 as INP Station Commander, Dagami,
Leyte; 1974-76, Dep. Station Commander, Tacloban City; 1977-81, Station
Commander, Bureau, Leyte; 1981-84, Dep. Station Commander, Tacloban
City; 1984, Station Commander, Carigara, Leyte; 1984-85, Station
Commander, Palo, Leyte; 1985-86, Tm Ldr SGT, M1811, M188; 1986-88, Stn.
Commander, Ormoc City, and from 1988 up to when he had succumbed on
April 29, 1989, as INP Station Commander, Tacloban City;

WHEREAS, we gravely feel the irreparable loss of a conscientious and peace loving man and friend, who during his terms of office had won for himself the distinction of a scrupulous worker, remaining faithful to his avowed duties and responsibilities, and a devoted public servant;

WHEREAS, we greatly share the grief and sorrow with Mrs. Eufracia U. Bardillon, her son and daughters, the sadness and woe with the in-law, brothers, sisters, grandchildren, and other relatives of the late INP-Station Commander of Tacloban City, Police Major Gabriel Bardillon, for the passing away of a caressing husband, a dutiful father and an accommodating kin;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Rodolfo L. Rivilla, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Peace and Order and, unanimously seconded by the mga Kagawad; be it

RESOLVED, to express our deepest sympathy by way of condolence to Mrs. Eufracia U. Bardillon, her son and son-in-law, daughters, grandchildren and other relatives for the untimely death of her husband, the late Police Major Gabriel S. Bardillon, and do, as this Body hereby does, join in mourning and profoundly share in grief and sorrow, anguish and pain, sadness and woes of the bereaved family and clan in this, their hour of bereavement;
