RESOLUTION NO. 8

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL RED CROSS, MANILA, TO ESTABLISH A RED CROSS CHAPTER IN ORMOC CITY WITH PROPOSED CHAPTER MEMBERS THEREOF TO INCLUDE FOURTEEN (14) SURROUNDING MUNICIPALITIES, AS ENUMERATED HEREOF.

WHEREAS, for years, Ormoc City has remained but an Extension Office to Tacloban Chapter of the Philippine National Red Cross and, as such Red Cross services to Ormoc City and its surrounding municipalities are limited, for the primary concern of services is the base chapter which is Tacloban City;

WHEREAS, besides the population of the surrounding municipalities of Ormoc City, the city itself, which has progressed by leaps and bounds in the last decade, has a mushrooming population of over 130,000, yet, notwithstanding, there is only one Red Cross personnel assigned in these areas to attend to all kinds of services, especially major and emergency services, like calamities, accidents, various illness requiring blood transfusions, medicines, etcetera, round the clock, which, even through Herculean efforts and dedication, these services, in an enormous area of jurisdiction and responsibility, cannot be availed of at all times by just a One-Man-Office-Staff whereby, practically all problems and communications are channeled through and subjected for study and approval by the Chapter Administrator at Tacloban City before final approval at the National Office, - a very protracted process causing unnecessary delay;

WHEREAS, for a fast growing place like Ormoc City, a full representation to the National Headquarter is vitally needed so that very pertinent problems concerning welfare and assistance to our people-in-need could be immediately attended to and promptly acted upon;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Celso P. Adolfo, duly seconded by Mga Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr., Eufrocino C. Codilla, Jr., Sixto T. Pongos, Rodolfo L. Rivilla, Jr. and Benjamin F. Tugonon; be it

RESOLVED, to earnestly request the Philippine National Red Cross, Manila, to establish a Red Cross Chapter in Ormoc City, with Ormoc City as the base chapter, and with the proposed Chapter Members thereto, the following fourteen (14) municipalities with their corresponding boundaries or territories compact and adjacent to Ormoc City, to wit: Palompon, Tabango, Villaba, Kananga, Matag-ob, Isabel, Merida, Albura, Baybay, Bato, Hindang, Inopacan, Hilongos and Matalom.




