RESOLUTION NO. 94

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY ADDRESSED TO THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, MANILA, HIGHLY RECOMMENDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. NELSON DL. GENESTON AS MEMBER OF THE FIFTH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOG, ORMOG CITY, REPRESENTING THE INDUSTRIAL LABOR SECTOR.

WHEREAS, for the immediately preceding two decades, more or less, up to now, the introduction of light and heavy industries in Ormoc City has heightened due to the central and strategic location of the place, the boom in the agricultural sector, the existence of excellent road network, and the easy accessibility of the place by air and sea and other available transport facilities that a common traveler and businessman can afford;

WHEREAS, corollary to the industrial advancement, comes the emergence and increase of industrial organizations together with all the problems, inherent and accidental, attached to any grouping or association;

WHEREAS, with the aforesaid industrial growth, and, in line with Sec. 173 Par. 5 of the Local Government Code, re The Sangguniang Panlungsod, Its Composition, which expressly reads: "In addition thereto, there shall be one representing X X X from the X X X industrial labor sector who shall be appointed by the President of the Philippines whenever, as determined by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, said sector is of sufficient number in the city to warrant representation, after consultation with associations and persons belonging to the sector concerned", thus, the Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc strongly believe as indispensable the necessity of recommending as a new Member to the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, one (1) Representative by the person of Mr. NELSON DL. GENESTON, a labor organizer and President of the MIDECO Association of Workers, (MAW), 1974-80, to represent the Industrial Labor sector;

WHEREAS, after a painstaking study and deliberations, aside favorable indorsements from industrial groups, this august Body finds out that Mr. Nelson DL. Geneston is qualified for the position, owing to his previous experiences as a labor leader, having uplifted the living conditions of his peers when he organized the MIBECO Credit Cooperative, Inc., thereby eliminating the loan sharks in the Company he worked;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Rodolfo L. Rivilla, Jr., duly seconded by mga Kagawad Eufreacio C. Codilla, Jr. and Celso P. Porradilla; be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution respectfully addressed to the Honorable Secretary of Local Government, Manila, HIGHLY RECOMMENDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. NELSON DL. GENESTON AS MEMBER OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC, ORMOC CITY, REPRESENTING THE INDUSTRIAL LABOR SECTOR;

ENACTED, July 20, 1989.


