

RESOLUTION NO. 95

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY ADDRESSED TO HONORABLE SECRETARY LUIS T. SANTOS, DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT, MANILA, HIGHLY RECOMMENDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. SOLOMON S. CHU AS MEMBER OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC, ORMOC CITY, REPRESENTING THE AGRICULTURAL LABOR SECTOR.

WHEREAS, aside industrial growth in Ormoc City brought about by the existence of the Philippine-Japan-Highway and other road network, the accessibility of the place by air and sea and other transport facilities of a traveling businessman, Ormoc City, too, has long been with a boom in agriculture due to its excellent strategic location in the province of Leyte and its God-given fertility of the soil;

WHEREAS, hand in hand with the tremendous agricultural growth, comes the rise and increase of agricultural organizations, together with those problems inherently or accidentally attached to any groupings or associations;

WHEREAS, with the aforesaid agricultural projections and growth, and, in line with Sec. 173 Par. 5 of the Local Government Code, re The Sangguniang Panlungsod, Its Composition, which expressly provides: "In addition thereto, there shall be one representative X X I from the agricultural X X X labor sector who shall be appointed by the President of the Philippines whenever, as determined by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, said sector is of sufficient number in the city to warrant representation, after consultation with associations and persons belonging to the sector concerned", thus, the Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc strongly believe as indispensable the necessity of recommending as a new Member to the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, one (1) Representative in the person of Mr. SOLOMON S. CHU, an independent-minded civic leader and businessman, to represent the Agricultural Labor sector;

WHEREAS, after a painstaking study and serious considerations, aside favorable endorsements from agricultural associations, this august Body finds out that Mr. Solomon S. Chu is qualified for the position, owing to his experiences in this field of expertise which will surely help to a great extent this present Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, in particular, and the Local Government of Ormoc City, in general, carry out corresponding tasks;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Rodolfo L. Rivilla, Jr., duly seconded by Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrasorza, Jr.; be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution respectfully addressed to Honorable Secretary Luis T. Santos, Department of Local Government, Manila, HIGHLY RECOMMENDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF MR. SOLOMON S. CHU AS MEMBER OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC, ORMOC CITY, REPRESENTING THE AGRICULTURAL LABOR SECTOR;
