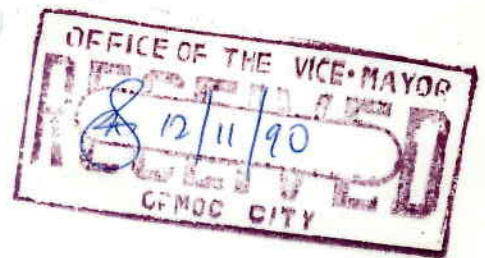

RESOLUTION NO. 159

A RESOLUTION HIGHLY REQUESTING THE MANAGEMENT OF PHILIPPINE LONG  
DISTANCE TELEPHONE COMPANY, MANILA, FOR IMMEDIATE ASSISTANCE IN  
REHABILITATING THE TELEPHONE LINES IN ORMOC CITY DAMAGED BY TYPHOON  
"RUPING".

WHEREAS, Ormoc City was one of the many places in Western and  
Eastern Visayas mercilessly hit by the devastating super-typhoon  
"Ruping" last November 12 to 13, 1990;

WHEREAS, this unmitigated fury of nature had lashed out untold  
damages to properties, (aside injury and loss of lives), and, included  
in the damages were the many telephone poles being blown down or  
damaged, cutting off telephone wires rendering the linkage or the  
process of communication to many ends in some places within the city  
proper and immediate suburbs obstructed UP TO NOW;

WHEREAS, this impossibility of telephone contacts in some areas in  
Ormoc City has daunted the interest of would be telephone callers to  
make important or emergency calls, and, on the process, has obstructed  
the Program of the City Government on rendering or overseeing of  
continuing services to its constituents, especially in catastrophic  
instances, one, like this, wherein there are the helpless and  
unfortunate victims of the calamity who surely are much in need of help  
or assistance from the government;


