

RESOLUTION NO. 175

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY URGING THE COMMANDING OFFICER, HEADQUARTERS - 2ND COAST GUARD DISTRICT. CEBU CITY, TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A LIGHT HOUSE AT STRATEGIC AREA IN TULANG, SAN FRANCISCO, CAMOTES ISLAND, CEBU, 30 AS TO AVERY OR MINIMIZE SEA ACCIDENTS AND OTHER UNTOWARD DANGERS EXPOSED TO SHIPS AND OTHER VESSELS WHICH ARE TO PASS THROUGH THE STRAIT OF TULANG.

WHEREAS, a letter dated 16 December 1990 from Mr. R. M. Hermosilla, President, Ormoc Consumers Association, this city, addressed Her Honor, the City Mayor, the latter having endorsed the same to the Honorable Sangguniang Panlungsod for appropriate action, said letter having informed about the sinking incident of M/V Boholana Princess of the Sulpicio Lines at Tulang, Camotes Island, - a second maritime accident to happen on ships plying Ormoc-Cebu route, (the first incident, that of M/V Ramon Aboltiz), resulting to a serious cause of apprehension and concern among sea commuters that Tulang has proven itself a maritime threat to shipping, thereby sincerely requesting the proper agency/cies to construct and maintain a light house at strategic area in Tulang;

WHEREAS, also in separate instances, a good many a civic groups in Drac City have personally conveyed to the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, their views and concern regarding feasibility and importance of putting up a light house in Tulang;

WHEREAS, this august Body fully believes that having a light house at strategic place in Tulang is indispensable to serve as signal light to approaching ships that are to pass through its narrow passageway;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kaqawad Rodolfo L. Rivilla, Jr., Committee on Transportation and Communications, jointly seconded by mga Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr. and Edgar Z. Palugod; be it
