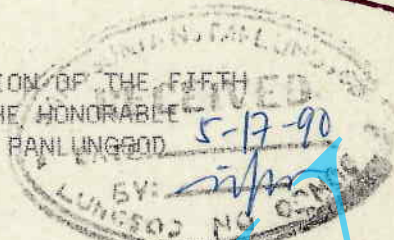

RESOLUTION NO. 53

A RESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING VICE PRESIDENT ASISCLO T. GONZAGA, NATIONAL POWER CORPORATION, VISAYAS REGIONAL CENTER, CEBU, TO INSTALL ADDITIONAL POWER TRANSFORMER IN ORMOC CITY.

WHEREAS, Ormoc City with its area and resources ideal to investors and businessmen for the establishment of factories and other businesses due to its plentiful of water supply, God-given fertility of the soil, and the existence of the Philippine-Japan Highway and other network and its excellent strategic location being at the crossroads of commerce easily accessible to many areas and places in the country, has been, in the immediately preceding two decades up to now, enjoying its industrial growth with the heightening in the introduction of light and heavy industries as well as it has long been in boom in the agricultural sector;

WHEREAS, the series of brownout which the constituents of Ormoc City have been experiencing for the past many months up to now due to power failure existing in the National Power Corporation, have proven detrimental to the mechanical work and functioning of machines in factories and other establishments and very damaging to households appliances;

WHEREAS, according to very reliable information, there is a plan of transfer of NPC's 30 MVA Transformer at Naga switchyard, Naga, Cebu to Leyte province, which news has become very encouraging among the Ormocanons who are hoping that, by the phrase "Leyte province", it would mean, in particular, to Ormoc City being then a place in the Leyte province, thus, in so doing, would lighten us with our burdensome problem of power shortage and brownout;


