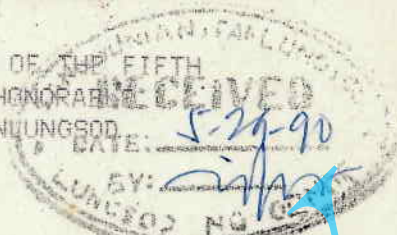
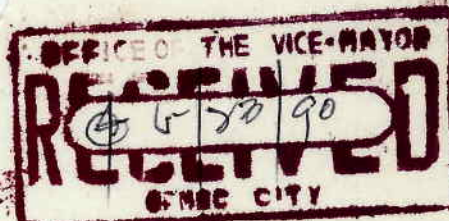

RESOLUTION NO. 56

A RESOLUTION OF CONDOLENCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY AND CLAN OF THE
LATE EX-COUNCILOR OF ORMOC CITY, HONORABLE PABLO S. PAJARON.

WHEREAS, this august Body bears the shock with which it takes the news of the death of a highly esteemed former Councilor of the previous Municipal Board of Ormoc City, now the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, Honorable PABLO S. PAJARON, who succumbed in the early morning last May 7, 1990;

WHEREAS, the late Pablo S. Pajaron, who was born, reared, labored and died in Ormoc City, according to reliable sources, was a self-made man with lofty ideals and with emulative gems of honesty, righteousness, simplicity, open-mindedness and love for his family, God and country which summed up together made him one rare citizen of our city and of our country that he truly was;

WHEREAS, reckoning back to his services in the government, the late Pablo S. Pajaron was a public school teacher, later on had launched his candidacy as Councilor of the former Municipal Board of Ormoc City, thus elected and became one of the first elected Councilors in Ormoc City from January 1, 1948 to December 31, 1951, and thereafter had returned to the teaching profession up to his retirement as a pensioner;

WHEREAS, the late Pablo S. Pajaron, with his dedication, vision and commitment to his job as the former Councilor of Ormoc City, had won for himself the distinction of a scrupulous worker and a devoted public servant, faithful to his avowed duties and responsibilities and, had a lot helped Ormoc City to its present status of a peaceful, progressive and beautiful city;

WHEREAS, the Honorable MEMBERS of the SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD ng ORMOG, having gravely felt the irreparable loss of a conscientious and peace loving man and friend, in SESSION, greatly shares the excruciating pain and sorrow with daughters and sons, Remedios, Jesusa, Antonia, Esperanza, Ricardo and Ben, respectively, as well as the anguish and despair with the sons-in-law, daughters-in-law, grandchildren and other relatives of the late Pablo S. Pajaron, for the passing away of a caressing, dutiful and affectionate father, and an accommodating kin who spent the best and declining years of his life in the service of his community and country and, could have been more in service thereto were he to live longer through the years;

RESOLVED, to express our most profound sympathy by way of condolence to all the daughters, sons, in-laws and other relatives of the deceased for the untimely death of said deceased, Honorable Pablo S.
