RESOLUTION NO. 90

A RESOLUTION OF CONDOLENCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY AND CLAN
OF THE LATE COLONEL TEOFILO T. MONCADA.

WHEREAS, this august Body bears the shock with which it takes the news of the sudden death of Colonel TEOFILO T. MONCADA, a Philippine Veteran, an educator and a former Chief of the Ormoc City Fire Department, who succumbed in the early morning last July 30, 1990;

WHEREAS, the late Col. Teofilo T. Moncada, who was born, reared, labored and died in Ormoc City, according to very reliable sources, was a self-made man with lofty ideals and emulative gems of honesty, righteousness, courage, open-mindedness and love for his family, God and country which summed up together made him one rare citizen of our city and of our country that he truly was;

WHEREAS, reckoning back to his services in the government, the late Teofilo T. Moncada was a diligent public school teacher and an efficient school administrator for so many years; also, he had served as a Fire Chief of the Ormoc City Fire Department;

WHEREAS, during the Japanese occupation, the late Col. Teofilo T. Moncada was a good and fearless guerrilla soldier who became one of the highest and most powerful guerrilla officers, yet in no instance did he use his power and authority to enrich himself by exploiting and abusing the helpless civilians, instead, he used his power with honesty and dignity, and has always stood to defend the poor and the weak;

WHEREAS, the late Col. Teofilo T. Moncada, with his dedication, vision and commitment to good works had won for himself the distinction of a scrupulous worker and an exemplary man;

WHEREAS, this Honorable SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD ng ORMOC, having gravely felt the irreparable loss of a conscientious and peace loving man and friend, in SESSION, greatly shares the grief and sorrow with daughters Luster, Myrna and Grace, as well as the anguish and pain with son Teofilo, Jr., grandchildren and other relatives of the late Col. Teofilo T. Moncada for the passing away of a caressing and affectionate father and an accommodating kin who spent the best years of his lime in the service of his community and country and could have been more of service thereto were he live longer through the years;
