RESOLUTION NO. 09

A RESOLUTION APPROVING RESOLUTION NO. 1, S. 1991 EMBODYING ORDINANCE NO. 1 OF THE BARANGAY COUNCIL OF BARANGAY 17, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE FIXING FEES FOR CERTAIN ACTIVITIES AND ITEMS OF COMMERCE WITHIN BARANGAY 17, ORMOC CITY, WITH CERTAIN AMENDMENTS.

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of Resolution No. 1, S. 1991 adopting Ordinance No. 1 of the Barangay Council of Barangay 17, entitled, "An Ordinance Fixing Fees for Certain Activities and Items of Commerce within Barangay 17, this city;

WHEREAS, said resolution has alleged the following:

- That under Sections 26 and 27 of PD 251 as amended, the Barangays are empowered to levy taxes or fees at rates that shall not exceed twenty-five (25%) percent of similar specific taxes already imposed by the municipality;
- That certain provisions also permit the barangays to raise funds for their operations;
- That said barangay faces an imperative need to raise funds for essential barangay development projects;

WHEREAS, this august Body finds no hindrance to the approval of said resolution-ordinance, except in Section 1 the fee imposed per sack of charcoal stored be reduced from P0.50 to P0.10 because the city is imposing P0.30 only and in Section 2, the words "and private" be deleted, that means that the ordinance would be applicable only to commercial purposes, so that said sections would now read:

(RES. NO. 09, S. 1991)

- a) "Section 1. That there shall be imposed a fee of P0.10 per sack of charcoal stored for commercial purposes within the jurisdictional confines of Barangay 17;
- b) "Section 2. There shall also be imposed a fee of P2.00 per head of swine roasted within the barangay for commercial purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Benjamin F. Tugonon, duly seconded by Kagawad Nelson DL. Geneston; be it


RESOLVED, to approve Resolution No. 1, s. 1990, embodying Ordinance No. 1, entitled, "An Ordinance Fixing Fees for Certain Activities and Items of Commerce within Barangay 17, with certain amendments.

ENACTED, February 14, 1991.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution one each to the Honorable City Mayor, the ABC President and the Barangay Council of Barangay 17, all in Ormoc City;
