

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING FIRST AGVA CORPORATION, THROUGH MR. BEN JAVELLANA, STATE CONDOMINIUM I, MAKATI, METRO MANILA, TO PUT UP A PASSENGER VESSEL FOR THE ORMOC-CEBU (VICE VERSA) ROUTE WITH NO LESS THAN 700 PASSENGERS CAPACITY AND 100 IONS CARGO CAPACITY.

WHEREAS, The Honorable Sangguniang Panlungsod is in receipt of a letter from Her Honor, the City Mayor, the full text of said letter is hereunder cited as follows:

Dear Mr Javellana:

The principal medium of travel for the Ormoc-Cebu (vice versa) route is by sea. Nevertheless, the ships that currently ply this route are very insufficient to cope up with so many commuters in Ormoc City and its neighboring municipalities.

In this connection, may we request your company to put up a passenger vessel for the aforementioned route with no less than 700 passengers capacity and 100 tons cargo capacity.

Thank you very much in anticipation of your kind assistance to our request.

WHEREAS, it is a sincere belief of this august Body that the aforecited letter-request is very meritorious, for it would mean an accommodation of additional vessel to facilitate the services necessary to the riding public and their cargoes, thus probably would solve the prevailing problem about stranded commuters in Ormoc City from far flung places who are desiring to avail of the schedule of ships depature and, which development has strained the social services of the city;
