RESOLUTION NO. 90

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE DIRECTOR, BUREAU OF FISHERIES AND AQUATIC RESOURCES, QUEZON CITY, TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF CABINGTAN LAKE IN ORMOC CITY RELATIVE TO THE ECOLOGY AND SUITABILITY OF SAID LAKE FOR TOURIST DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, perhaps not much is known about Cabingtang Lake, some eighteen (18) kilometers, more or less, away Northeast from Ormoc City, due to the scarcity of advertisement or publication of said lake, and, probably only a handful few of our national public officials have actually gone to said place to enjoy and endear the picturesque and oblong shaped nature's wonder - the Cabingtang Lake;

WHEREAS, the lake has derived its name Cabingtang from a nearby barangay, Brgy. cabingtang, (one of Ormoc City's vegetable-producing barangays, having an elevation of about 800 meters above sea level and with a climate of extreme coldness), and, according to reliable sources, Lake Cabingtang is abundant in aquatic resources that most barangay folks are taking advantage of its species and existence;

WHEREAS, through the representation of Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr., Vice-Chairman, Committee on Natural Resources, this august Body has become knowledgeable of the request of Mr. Ruperto Sievert of Program and Management Office - Fisheries Sector Program, c/o Department of Agriculture - Regional Office, Tacloban, for the Honorable Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc to pass a resolution requesting the Director of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources to conduct a study of said Cabingtang Lake, its ecology and suitability for tourist development;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr., duly seconded by Kagawad Rodolfo L. Rivilla, Jr.; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to earnestly request the Director, Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources, Quezon City, to conduct a study of Cabingtian Lake in Ormoc City relative to the Ecology and suitability of said lake for tourist development;
