RESOLUTION NO. 27

EARNESTLY REQUESTING THE MARITIME INDUSTRY RESOLUTION AUTHORITY (MARINA), MANILA, TO ALLOW SHIPPING COMPANIES OTHER THAN THE ABOITIZ AND THE SULPICIO SHIPPING LINES TO PLY ORMOC-CEBU AND ORMOC-MANILA AND VICE-VERSA ROUTES.

WHEREAS, aside from the usual heavy influx of commuters and goods to and from Ormoc City, there is the prevailing situation of stranded commuters in the city from far flung municipalities and provinces wishing to avail of the scheduled ship departure from Ormoc City which has strained the social services of the said city;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Ormoc, through official public pronouncement by His Honor, Mayor Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr., during the Inaugural Session of the Sixth Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc at Monorable Placido Enecio Hall, this city, on June 30, 1992, has declared that the Ormoc City Port is an Open Port;

WHEREAS currently, the Ormoc pier is undergoing construction and repairs for additional 50-meter lengthening and 50-meter widening, believed to give sufficient space to accommodate more ships;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion presented by Kagawad Jose C. Alfaro, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Transportation & Communications, severally econded by mga Kagawad Alfredo F. Capahi, Claudio F. Larrazabal and Mariano Y. Corro; be it;

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to earnestly request the Maritime Industry Authority (MARINA), Manila, to allow shipping companies other than the Aboitiz and the Sulpicio Shipping Lines to ply Ormoc-Cebu and Ormoc-Manila and vice versa routes;
