RESOLUTION NO. 30

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING HIS EXCELLENCY, PRESIDENT FIDEL V.  
RAMOS, TO DEFER THE FIRST ELECTIONS OF SECTORAL  
REPRESENTATIVES.

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt on 10th February 1993 of  
Memorandum Circular No. 93-12 dated 3 February 1993 from the Honorable  
Secretary Rafael M. Alunan III, Department of Interior & Local  
Government, Manila, Re Determination of Sectors to be represented in the  
Second and Third Sectors of the Sanggunians, wherein as cited in said  
memorandum, "the President made the following policy pronouncements:

"That an enabling law will be passed providing, among  
others, the date and manner of conducting the First Sectoral  
Elections including the necessary appropriations;

"That the local sanggunian that have not determined the  
sectors to be represented in the Second and Third Sectors will  
immediately convene to decide on their choices; and

"That the issues and problems raised by the local  
government units particularly on compensation of sectoral  
representatives will be properly addressed in the rules and  
regulations that will implement the law on sectoral elections."

WHEREAS, the aforecited memorandum has further stated that "the  
sanggunian concerned are hereby directed to determine as soon as  
possible but not later than 15 February 1993 the appropriate sectors  
existing in their respective local government units to be represented in  
the second and third sectors, X X X X"

WHEREAS, the City Government is financially hard up at present due  
to the fact that it has just newly rehabilitated from out of its  
monstrous destructions and damages due to typhoon Uring, hence, can not

afford to pay the compensations and other monetary benefits for the sectoral representatives;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Claudio P. Larrazabal, duly seconded by Kagawad Celso P. Adolfo; be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution REQUESTING HIS EXCELLENCY, PRESIDENT FIDEL V. RAMOS, TO DEFER THE FIRST ELECTIONS OF SECTORAL REPRESENTATIVES;

ENACTED, February 11, 1993.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution each to His Excellency, President Fidel V. Ramos, Malacañang Palace, Manila; Honorable Secretary Rafael M. Alunan III, Secretary - DILG, Manila; Honorable Mayor Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr., City Mayor, Ormoc City; Atty. Filelina S. Oliver, Registrar, COMELEC, Ormoc City, and the DILG-ACGO Officer, Ormoc City;

CARRIED by MAJORITY VOTES, with nine (9) affirmative votes, two (2) objections registered by mga Kagawad Jose C. Alfaro, Jr. and Jose B. Conejos, the latter two mga Kagawad are for indefinite deferment.
