RESOLUTION NO. 16

A RESOLUTION TAKING COGNIZANCE AND FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE
TRANSFER OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICES IN THE CITY GOVERNMENT:
A) PUBLIC SERVICES DIVISION- FROM THE CITY ENGINEER'S
OFFICE TO THE GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT, AND B)
MOTORPOOL DIVISION - FROM THE CITY ENGINEER'S OFFICE TO
THE CITY MAYOR'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of a letter dated 5
November 1993 from the Honorable City Mayor informing, among others, of
the transfer of some offices of the City Government, namely:

	From	To
a)	City Library - City Mayor's Office	Sangguniang Panlungsod
b)	Public Services Division - City Engineer's Office	General Services Department
c)	Security Services Division - City Mayor's Office	General Services Department
d)	Motorpool Division - City Engineer's Office	General Services Department

And, requesting this sanggunian for legislative action regarding the
said movement or transfer;

WHEREAS, subsequently, however, a follow-up communication dated 24 January 1994 from the same Office of the City Mayor has made reconsiderations of the transfer of some city offices, as follows:

- a) Retention of the City Library under the Office of the City Mayor, for the transfer of the City Library to the Office of the Secretary of the Sangguniang Panlungsod "may be premature and may not be financially viable and beneficial to all concern." (As Corrected).
- b) Retention of the Security Services Division or Civil Security Unit under the Office of the City Mayor, instead of having said Unit transferred earlier to the General Services Department. (As Corrected).
- c) Transfer of the Public Services Division from the City Engineer's Office to the General Services Department.
- d) Transfer of the Motorpool Division from the City Engineer's Office to the City Mayor's Office "in line with MC No. 93-18 of DILG prescribing policies and providing guidelines in relation to Memo Cir. No. 92-53 which provides among others the supervision of the Equipment Pool directly under the Office of the City Mayor (Item V Administration)."

WHEREAS, it is the observation of this august Body that the City Mayor, as Chief Executive of the city, has the ultimate prerogative in moving or transferring city offices in the interest of a more responsive and effective services to the constituents -

"For efficient, effective and economical governance the purpose of which is the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of the Code, the city mayor shall exercise general supervision and control over all X X X services and activities of the city X X X" (Article 86, Par.

(b) - Rules & Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991. (Underscoring Supplied))

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Sotero M. Pepito, Chairman, Committee on Good Government & Ethics, duly seconded by Kagawad Celso P. Adolfo; be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution A RESOLUTION TAKING COGNIZANCE AND FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE TRANSFER OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICES IN THE CITY GOVERNMENT: A) PUBLIC SERVICES DIVISION- FROM THE CITY ENGINEER'S OFFICE TO THE GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT, AND B) MOTORPOOL DIVISION - FROM THE CITY ENGINEER'S OFFICE TO THE CITY MAYOR'S OFFICE;

ENACTED, January 27, 1994.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution each to His Honor, the City Mayor, all Department Heads of the City Government, Ormoc City;

CARRIED by MAJORITY VOTES, with eleven (11) affirmative votes, and one (1) abstention registered by Kagawad Sixto T. Pongos.
