RESOLUTION NO. 98

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING SECRETARY ROBERTO S. SEBASTIAN, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE THROUGH UNDERSECRETARY JOEMARI D. GEROCHI, TO INCLUDE IN THE PRIORITY PROJECTS OF THE GEROCHE, TO INCLUDE IN THE COMMUNITY UNGMITTED OF PROGRAM THE COMMUNITY UNGMITTED OF THE COASTAL BARANGAYS OF THE COASTAL FISHERIES COMMUNITY ORGANIZING COMPONENT ORMOC, IT BEING A PART OF ORMOC BAY,

WHEREAS, there is a circular from Undersecretary Joemari D. Gerochi indicating the tight cash situation of the Fishery Sector Program resulting in the deferment of certain activities including the Community Organizing Component of Coastal Barangay on Coastal Resource Management (CRM) in Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the Resources & Environmental Assessment has found out that the near-shore coastal area of Ormoc Bay is heavily over-fished and silted which necessitates proper Coastal Resource Management through education and community organizing;

WHEREAS, the Community organizing component in other coastal towns composing the Ormoc Bay Area specifically Merida and Albuera is on-going or completed and only Ormoc is left and this may jeopardize the whole Coastal Resource Management of Ormoc Bay;

WHEREAS, the University of the Philippines (U.P.), Visayas in their Resource Ecological Appraisal of Ormoc Bay found the heavy presence of toxic metal like Cadmium, Mercury and Lead in Ormoc Bay and proper implementation of the Coastal Resource Management will enable the Community to appropriately protect itself;

WHEREFORE, above facts considered, on motion of Kagawad Jose Alfaro, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Control severally seconded by Kagawad Mariano Y. Corro, Claudio Larrazabal, and Alfredo F. Capahi; be it
