RESOLUTION NO. 104

RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING BARANGAY OFFICIALS TO A RESOLUTION DISSEMINATE INFORMATIONN WITHIN THEIR TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION THE PROVISIONS OF ACT 3753 (CIVIL REGISTRY LAW SPECIFICALLY ON THE COMPULSORY REGISTRATION OF BIRTH, FOUNDLING, MARRIAGE AND DEATH OF A THE FACT PERSON IN THE OFFICE OF THE LOCAL CIVIL REGISTRAR WITHIN THE PERIOD PRESCRIBED THEREIN TO AVOID THE PENALTY FOR FAILURE TO REGISTER AND DELAYED REGISTRATION THEREOF, TO COORDINATE WITH THE LOCAL CIVIL REGISTRAR CONCERNING THE AFOREMENTIONED ACTIVITY.

WHEREAS, government surveys reveal that every year so many births, foundlings, marriages and deaths occurring in the Philippines are registered in the Office of the Local Civil Registrar;

WHEREAS, this big number of under-registration adversely affects the progress of the government in promoting health and social conditions of the people especially the youth because of the difficulty in gathering complete vital statistics due to the under-registration of these vital events:

WHEREAS, Act 3753 (Civil Registry Law) mandates the compulsory registration of vital events in the Office of the Local Civil Registrar free of charge so as to encourage the registration thereof;

WHEREAS, under the aforecited law, the reglementary period for registration of these vital events is within thirty (30) days from the occurrence thereof, except in the case of marriage which should be done within fifteen (15) days following the solemnization of the marriage in the case of ordinary marriages, and within thirty (30) days following the solemnization of the marriage in the case of marriages exempt from the license requirement;

WHEREAS, the same aforecited law imposes a penalty of a fine of not less than P10.00 nor more than P200.00 upon conviction of any person who violates any provisions of said law;

WHEREAS, Section 394 (c) (5) of Republic 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, requires Barangay Secretary to assist the Local Civil Registrar in the registration of births, deaths and marriages occurring in his jurisdiction;

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of Kagawad Mariano Y. Corro, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, jointly seconded by mga Kagawad Nestor C. Penserga and Benjamin B. Lladoc; be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to pass a resolution respectfully requesting Barangay Officials to disseminate information within their jurisdiction the provisions of Act 3753 (Civil Registry Law) specifically on the compulsory registration of the fact of birth, foundling, marriage and death of a person in the Office of the Local Civil Registrar within the period prescribed therein to avoid the penalty for failure to register and delayed registration thereof, and to coordinate with the Local Civil Registrar concerning the aforementioned activity;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution, one copy each, to: Civil Registrar General Tomas P. Africa, National Statistics Office, Sta. Mesa, Metro Manila, the Honorable City Mayor Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr., the Asting Civil Registrar, All Punong Barangays, the President of the Association of Barangay Councils (ABC) and all others concerned, all in Ormon City;
