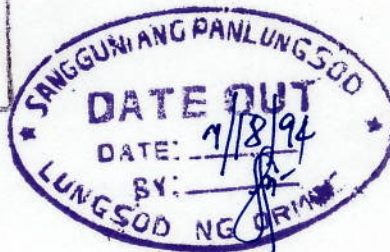
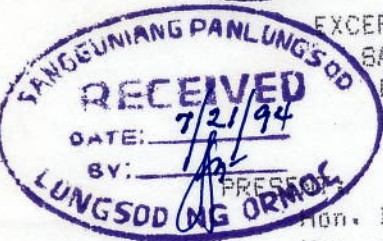

RESOLUTION NO. 120

A RESOLUTION DEFINING THE STAND OF THE SANGGUNIANG
PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC REGARDING THE REQUEST OF PNOC FOR AN
INDORSEMENT OF THEIR "LEYTE A GEOTHERMAL PROJECT".

WHEREAS, there is a pending request of the PNOC for an indorsement
of their "Leyte A Geothermal Project" in Tongonan, Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the Power Rate in Region VIII in general, and that of
Ormoc City and environs in particular, are among the highest in the
country inspite of the fact that Ormoc City is the source of the
geothermal power energy;

WHEREAS, recent events and studies indicate that the concentration
of the national government's effort to promote industries are focused
only in urban areas with developed infrastructure, transportation and
communications, and social amenities like Cebu and the provinces near
Metro Manila, while Region VIII which is a potential geothermal source
is relegated only to the role of supplying its natural resources
(geothermal energy) to these developed areas;

WHEREAS, the underdeveloped Region VIII in general and Ormoc City
in particular, want to fulfill their dreams and craving to improve
their economy through industrial development;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned dreams and craving can best be achieved
only if the competitive edge of the locality is enhanced through the
abundance of exclusive allocated power supply and preferential rate made
available only to the host locality, and this will place Ormoc at pace
with the vision of the President for the year 2000;

WHEREAS, finally, it is the sincere intention of this Sangguniang
Panlungsod to give full cooperation to the industrialization program of
the President;

NOW, THEREFORE, on MASS MOTION of the BODY and with OVERWHELMING SECONDS, be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution defining the stand of the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Ormoc City to give the requested indorsement of PNOC for the "Leyte A Geothermal Project" only if there is an allocated power for Region VIII in general, and Ormoc City in particular, in accordance with the recommended need of our City Planning Office or the NEDA;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to request the Department of Energy to give preferential rate to host localities which are the sources of energy and to attract investors to Ormoc City;

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, to furnish copies of this resolution, one each, to Secretary Delfin Lizardo, Department of Energy; President Raul Manglapus of PNOC; President Francisco L. Viray of NPC; Ms. Agnes de Jesus, Manager, Environmental Management Division, PNOC; Mayor Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr., City Mayor, Ormoc City; Mr. Wilfredo N. Aigopera, Resident Manager, PNOC-Geothermal Plant, Tongonan, Ormoc City; the City Planning Office and NEDA;
