RESOLUTION NO. 95-61

A RESOLUTION SINCERELY REQUESTING HIS EXCELLENCY,
PRESIDENT FIDEL V. RAMOS, PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF
THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT, THROUGH
THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH), TO
PROVIDE FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL AND MONITORING ASSISTANCE
FOR THE ORMOC CITY FLOOD CONTROL AND ENVIRONMENTAL
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, perennial floods are the greatest problem in Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the November 5, 1991 flashflood caused a toll damage of
hundreds of millions of pesos and claimed 8,000 lives;

WHEREAS, the Republic of the Philippines, through the DPWH and
Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), has commissioned CTI
Engineering Co. Ltd., in association with Pacific Consultants
International, to prepare a study on Flood Control for Rivers in
Selected Urban Centers of the country;

WHEREAS, the City of Ormoc is one of the independent component
cities selected to be a pilot area for the Program, whereby such study
was made without cost to the recipient cities;

WHEREAS, in a meeting held on August 24, 1995 at NEDA, Amber
Avenue, Pasig, Metro Manila, the Investment Coordinating Committee -
Technical Board (ICC-TB) recommended that the City Government of Ormoc
shall be the implementing agency and that the project will be financed
through Grant-in-Aid (GAP) from the Government of Japan;

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the national government and
the local government units shall share in the cost of land acquisition
and resettlement areas;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Ormoc has already spent so much in the acquisition of lots to be used as resettlement areas and will provide further for the basic facilities of the resettlement areas such as pave roads, water supply, street lighting, etcetera;

WHEREAS, considering the financial position and technical capability of the city, it is impossible for us to undertake the project despite its paramount necessity in abating future flood/s;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 31, second paragraph of R.A. 7160 page 26, to quote "In the event an LGU cannot finance the adequate delivery of basic services and facilities, the President, may, upon request of the LGU concerned, direct the appropriate national government agency to provide financial, technical or other form of assistance";

NOW, THEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of Kagawad Claudio P. Larrazabal, Chairman, Committee on Infrastructures, severally seconded by mga Kagawad Benjamin B. Lladoc, Sotero M. Pepito, Jose C. Alfaro, Jr., and Fernando P. Parrilla; be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution SINCERELY REQUESTING HIS EXCELLENCY, PRESIDENT FIDEL V. RAMOS, PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT, THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH), TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL, TECHNICAL AND MONITORING ASSISTANCE FOR THE ORMOC CITY FLOOD CONTROL AND ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT;
