## RESOLUTION NO. 95-73

SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT REPAEL M. ALUNAN ITT HIS OPTIMES AND LOCAL A REALLYTINA RESPECTIVLLY GOVERNMENT RAPAEL M. ALUNAN III HIS OPINION AS TO THE APPROPRIATE SALARY GRADES THAT THE VICE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC BELONG COMSIDERING THAT THERE IS NO SPECIFIC PROVISIONS IN THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1994 WHICH CATEGORIZE THE LOCAL FORMENTIONED CITY OFFICIALS IN THE CASE OF INDEPENDENT COMPONENT CITIES LIKE ORMOC CITY.

MEREAS. Article 77 of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991, categorizes the Salary Grades of Vice Mayor and Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod in Cities into two (2), namely: 1) highly urbanized; and 2) component. For VICE MAYOR, highlyurbanized SG 28; and, component SG 26. For MEMBERS OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD, highly urbanized SG 27 and, component SG 25:

WHEREAS, the aforecited article of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991 does not include in its categorization the Salary Grades of Vice Mayor and Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Independent Component Cities, like Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the Vice Mayor and the Members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc are presently receiving the salary equivalent to Salary Grades 26 and 25, respectively:

WHEREAS, Director Jacob F. Montesa, Department Legal Counsel of the Department of the Interior and Local Government in his OPINION NO. 95 S. 1994, quoting the decision of the Supreme Court in the consolidated cases of ABELLA VS. COMELEC AND LARRAZABAL, and LARRAZABAL VS. COMELEC and DE LA CRUZ (201 scra 253) has this to say:

"Section 12, Article X of the Constitution is explicit in that aside from highly urbanized cities, component cities whose charters prohibit their voters from voting for provincial elective officials are independent of the province. X X X . Necessarily, component cities like Grmoc City whose charters prohibit their voters from voting for provincial elective officials are treated like highly urbanized cities which are outside the supervisory power of the province to which they are geographically attached. X X X" (Underlining ours).

WHEREAS, it is the sense of the Members of the Sanggariang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, including the Presiding Officer who is the Vice Mayor, that in line of the aforequested oxinion of Director Jacob F. Montesa, which is buttressed by the aforecited decision of the Supreme Court, they are entitled to the compensation of the Salary Grades of highly-urbanized cities.

NOW, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE CONSIGNO PREMISES, on motion of Kagawad Mariano Y. Corro, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, severally seconded by aga kagawad Jose C. Alfaro, Jr., Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr. and Alfredo F. Capahi; be it

RESOLVAN. AS IT IS NERDLY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution RESPECTFULLY RESOLVEN. THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LICAL SOVERIMENT RAFAEL M. ALUNAN III HIS OPINION AS TO THE APPROPRIATE SALARY GRADES THAT THE VICE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE SANGGUNIANN PANLINGSID NG ORMOC BELONG CONSIDERING THAT THERE IS NO SPECIFIC PROVISIONS IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 WHICH CATEGORIZE THE NEOREMENTIONED CITY OFFICIALS IN THE CASE OF INDEPENDENT COMPONENT CITIES LIKE ORMOC CITY;

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to respectfully supplicate the Honorable Secretary Rafael M. Alunan III to facilitate the herein requested opinion, and to convey our sincerest thanks in anticipation for his prompt attention hereon;
