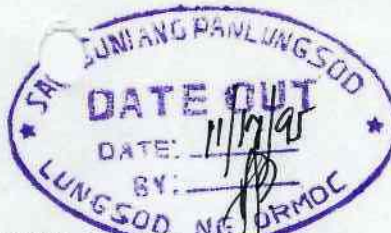

RESOLUTION NO. 95-128

A RESOLUTION ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P3.7M) AS CALAMITY AID FOR ORMOC CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES INCLUDING CASUAL AND EMERGENCY LABORERS FROM OUT OF THE FIVE PERCENT (5%) CALAMITY FUND OF THIS CITY.

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of a letter from the Honorable City Mayor dated 13 November 1995 addressed the Honorable Members of the 7th Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc thru the Honorable Vice Mayor and Presiding Officer, the full text of which is hereunder cited as follows:

Gentlemen:

I have the honor to request that a resolution be passed allocating the amount of THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P3.7M) from out of the Five Percent (5%) Calamity Fund as Calamity Aid to Ormoc City Government

Officials and employees including casual and emergency laborers of Ormoc City.

This is in line with Proclamation No. 669 issued by the Office of the President of the Philippines declaring Ormoc City in the State of Calamity adversely affected by tropical storm "Mameng". Copy hereto attached.

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 669 issued by the President of the Philippines (Copy hereto attached), Ormoc City has been declared under State of Calamity together with Metro Manila, Twenty Nine (29) Provinces and Nineteen (19) Cities including this city adversely affected by Tropical Storm "Mameng" and further directed all departments and other agencies concerned to "implement and execute relief and rehabilitation work in accordance with existing operational plans, directives and order issued in connection with calamities";

WHEREAS, said Calamity Aid is to be taken from out of the Five Percent (5%) Calamity Fund as stated in the aforecited letter of the Honorable City Mayor, and that the OIC-City Treasurer through 3rd Indorsement dated 16 November 1995 has stated that funds are available for the said purpose;

WHEREAS, the 7th Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc through the representation of the Honorable Chairman, Committee on Finance, has considered said request reasonable, hence, must be given due course;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Alfredo F. Capahi, Chairman, Committee on Finance, jointly seconded by mga Kagawad Sotero M. Pepito and Benjamin B. Lladoc; be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P3.7M) AS CALAMITY AID FOR ORMOC CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES INCLUDING CASUAL AND EMERGENCY LABORERS FROM OUT OF THE FIVE PERCENT (5%) CALAMITY FUND OF THIS CITY;



PROCLAMATION NO. 669

DECLARING A STATE OF CALAMITY IN METRO MANILA AND IN TWENTY
NINE (29) PROVINCES AND NINETEEN (19) CITIES ADVERSELY
AFFECTED BY TROPICAL STORM "MAMENG"

Upon recommendation of the Secretary of National Defense and Chairman of the National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC) and pursuant to the powers vested in me by law, I, **FIDEL V. RAMOS**, President of the Philippines, do hereby declare the existence of a State of Calamity in the areas adversely affected by tropical storm "Mameng".
