I have the honor to request that a resolution be passed allocating the amount of THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (#3.7M) from out of the Five Percent (5%) Calamity Fund as Calamity Aid to Ormoc City Government

Officials and employees including casual and emergency laborers of Ormoc City.

This is in line with Proclamation No. 669 issued by the Office of the President of the Philippines declaring Ormoc City in the State of Calamity adversely affected by tropical storm "Mameng". Copy hereto attached.

WHEREAS, Proclamation No. 669 issued by the President of the Philippines (Copy hereto attached), Proc. City has been declared under State of Calamity together with Metro Manyla, Thenty Nine (29) Provinces and Nineteen (19) Cities including this city advensely affected by Tropical Storm "Mameng" and further directed all appartments and other agencies concerned to "ipplement and execute velici and rehabilitation work in accordance with existing operational plans, directives and order issued in connection with calamities";

WHEREAS, sall Calamity Aid is to be taken from out of the Five Percent (5%) Calamity Fund as stated in the aforecited letter of the Honorable Cillagor, and that the OIC-City Treasurer through 3rd Indorsement dated (November 1975 has stated that funds are available for the said purpose)

WHXRES the 7th Sangguniang Panlungsod ng ormoc through the representation of the Honorable Chairman, Committee on Finance, has considered said request reasonable, hence, must be given due course;

NOV, TEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Alfredo F. Capahi, Chairman, Committee on Finance, jointly seconded by mga Kagawad Sotero M. Pepito and Projamin B. Lladoc; be it

RESOLVED, to pass a resolution ALLOCATING THE AMOUNT OF THREE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (\$3.7M) AS CALAMITY AID FOR DRMOC CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES INCLUDING CASUAL AND EMERGENCY LABORERS FROM DUT OF THE FIVE PERCENT (5%) CALAMITY FUND OF THIS CITY;
