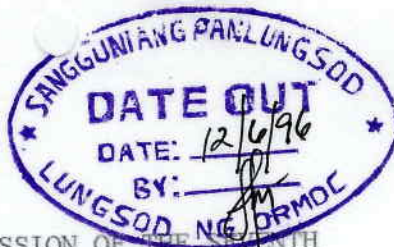

RESOLUTION NO. 96-233

A RESOLUTION RETURNING TO THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY OF BRGY. IPIL, ORMOC CITY, ITS BARANGAY ORDINANCE NO. 01-96 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF BARANGAY STREET AS OVERNIGHT PARKING AREA WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF IPIL PROPER, ORMOC CITY, WHEREIN THE SAID PARKING WILL CAUSE OBSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC TO FIRE ENGINES, TRUCKS, AND AMBULANCES DURING EMERGENCY", WITH THE REQUEST THAT THE FOLLOWING DEFICIENCIES BE CORRECTED/INCORPORATED, TO WIT: 1) PROVIDE A BRIEF EXPLANATORY NOTE CONTAINING THE JUSTIFICATION FOR ITS APPROVAL, TO COMPLY WITH ART. 107, PAR. (B) OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS IMPLEMENTING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, AND 2) INCORPORATE IN SECTION 1 THEREOF THAT WHAT IS PROHIBITED IS OVERNIGHT PARKING IN THE BARANGAY PROPER OF IPIL, SO AS TO CONFORM WITH THE TITLE OF SAID ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, submitted for review to this Sanggunian is Barangay Ordinance No. 01-96 of the Sangguniang Barangay of Ipil, Ormoc City, entitled, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF BARANGAY STREET AS OVERNIGHT PARKING AREA WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF IPIL, PROPER, ORMOC CITY, WHEREIN THE SAID PARKING WILL CAUSE OBSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC TO FIRE ENGINES, TRUCKS, AND AMBULANCES DURING EMERGENCY";

WHEREAS, a review made on the aforecited Ordinance disclosed the following deficiencies, to wit: 1) No explanatory note for the justification for its approval as required in Article 107, par. (b) of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991, and 2) Section 1 is at variance with the title of the Ordinance, hence, must be harmonized;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Mariano Y. Corro, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, duly seconded by Kagawad Benjamin B. Lladoc; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution RETURNING TO THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY OF BRGY. IPIL, ORMOC CITY, ITS BARANGAY ORDINANCE NO. 01-96 ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF BARANGAY STREET AS OVERNIGHT PARKING AREA WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF IPIL PROPER, ORMOC CITY, WHEREIN THE SAID PARKING WILL CAUSE OBSTRUCTION OF TRAFFIC TO FIRE ENGINES, TRUCKS, AND AMBULANCES DURING EMERGENCY", WITH THE REQUEST THAT THE FOLLOWING DEFICIENCIES BE CORRECTED/INCORPORATED, TO WIT: 1) PROVIDE A BRIEF EXPLANATORY NOTE CONTAINING THE JUSTIFICATION FOR ITS APPROVAL, TO COMPLY WITH ART. 107, PAR. (B) OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS IMPLEMENTING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991, AND 2) INCORPORATE IN SECTION 1 THEREOF THAT WHAT IS PROHIBITED IS OVERNIGHT PARKING IN THE BARANGAY PROPER OF IPIL, SO AS TO CONFORM WITH THE TITLE OF SAID ORDINANCE;
