this Sanggunian, through the Honorable Vice Mayor, is in receipt of a letter dated 6 February 1997 re: Requesting support for passage of Senate Bill No. 950 known as "Anti-Rape Bill", from the Coalition of Ormoc Women (or COW), this city, the full text of said letter is hereto cited as follows:

Dear Vice-Mayor Tugonon,

So much have been reported on rapes occurring almost monthly involving from the very lowly citizens to influential families like the Jalosjos and the Webbs. Despite the glaring news items in major national dailies, nothing has been done to put more teeth on our antiquated laws dealing with violence against women.

The organized women of this country tried hard to lobby an anti-rape bill in the last congress only to be archived by the then representative and now Cebu governor, Pablo Garcia.

Starting last year, the women again are lobbying hard to get this congress notice this. The organized women through SIBOL (Sama-samang Inisyatiba tungo sa pagbabago ng Batas at Lipunan) are again in frenzy to pass a law addressing the most heinous crime that could be done against a woman, rape.

Our dear vice-mayor, this sanggunian under your tutelage could very well contribute to the cause of the women in this country. Thus this letter requesting the Sanggunian to pass a resolution supporting Senate Bill No. 950 (Consolidated Version as of June, 1996) and urge other cities to do the same.

A comparative summary on the bill prepared by the Women's Legal Bureau (WLB-SIBOL) is herewith attached for your reference. These bills (Senate and House versions) are now with the bicameral committee of congress and the solons are in a hurry to pass this law in time for the International Women's Day on March 8.

Looking forward to your much needed support. We remain.
