

RESOLUTION NO. 97-173

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE SENTIMENT OF THE 7TH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF ORMOC CITY SUPPORTING THE STAND OF THE SOSEARTH DENOUNCING THE OPERATION OF IDHI WITHOUT THE PROPER ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE (ECC), AND CONSULTATION WITH THE RESIDENTS OF THE MGA BARANGAY IN ORMOC CITY WHICH WILL BE AFFECTED BY THEIR OPERATION.

WEREAS, presently operating at Barangay Benolho, Albuera, Leyte is a crusher plant owned by IDHI Mineral Corporation an affiliate of the Infrastructure Development and Holdings, Inc., whose major shareholders are said to be Rolando M. Zosa and a certain Dodong Tanchan, both from Cebu;

WHEREAS, by newspaper report of the Freeman, it states that the area covered by IDHI are Baybay, Albuera and Ormoc, said report is validated by their application dated January 2, 1997 as published in the Leyte-Samar Weekly dated July 12-18, 1997;

WHEREAS, the enormity and hugeness of the operation which is 3,200 cu.m. per day or equivalent to 320 ten wheeler trucks a day is too much for our ecosystem to carry considering that there are already many existing crushers in operation, hence, it is but proper that this august Body expresses its stand on the issue considering that Ormoc City is one of the areas affected;

WHEREFORE, premises, considered, on motion of Kagawad Jose C. Alfaro, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Control duly seconded by Kagawad Claudio P. Larrazabal; be it
