RESOLUTION NO. 98-95

A RESOLUTION SEEKING FROM THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL INSTITUTE AN ADVICE ON THE PROPRIETY OF RENAMING LILIA AVENUE AT BARANGAY COGON, THIS CITY, AS DOMINADOR M. TAN AVENUE PER LETTER REQUEST DATED 1 OCTOBER 1998 OF THE FAMILY AND SIBLINGS OF THE LATE CONGRESSMAN DOMINADOR M. TAN REPRESENTED BY ATTY. BENJAMIN F. TUGONON, LEGAL COUNSEL.

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of a letter dated 1 October 1998 from Atty. Benjamin F. Tugonon, Legal Counsel and as a friend of the Family and Siblings of the late Congressman Dominador M. Tan requesting for the passage and approval of an Ordinance renaming Lilia Avenue at Brgy. Cogon, this city, as Dominador M. Tan Avenue "in honor of a man who so unselfishly and dedicatedly served his City of Ormoc as part of the 4th District of Leyte";

WHEREAS, Section 13 Par.(b) of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, in part provides:

"(b) The Sanggunians of highly urbanized cities and component cities whose charters prohibit their voters from voting for provincial elective officials, hereinafter referred to in this Code as independent component cities, may in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of the following within its territorial jurisdiction.

XXX

(2) City roads, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares and bridges"; (Emphasis Supplied).

WHEREAS, the name of a local government unit or a public place, street or structure with historical, cultural or ethnic significance shall not be changed, unless by a unanimous vote of the sanggunian concerned and in consultation with the P.H.C. (Sec. 13 Par.(d) LGC 1991);

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of Kagawad Nepomuceno P. Aparis I, Chairman, Committee on Laws & Ordinances, severally seconded by mga Kagawad Benjamin B. Lladoc, Sotero M. Pepito, Fernando P. Parrilla and Chiqui B. Labagala; be it
