## RESOLUTION NO. 99

A RESOLUTION VEHEMENTLY OPPOSING THE PROPOSED CLOSURE OF ORNOC CITY PIER BY THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY (FRA) AND THE PROPOSED TRANSFER OF VESSEL DOCKING FROM ORMOC TO PALOMPON, LEYTE PORT.

WHEREAS, a proposal has been made by the Philippine Ports Authority to close the Ormoc City Pier for an undetermined period to undergo construction and to transfer the vessel docking from Ormoc to Palompon, Leyte, port;

WHEREAS, many sectors have expressed their opposition to the said plan considering that the transfer of vessels docking at Ormoc to Palompon port entails additional expenses and ultimately, it is the consumers who will suffer the consequences to the detriment of the local economy;

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that said port has undergone a widening for another three (3) meters sometime in 1991-1993 but it did not stop the normal operation at the said port;

WHEREAS, this august Body believes that the closure of the port as well as the transfer of vessel docking is indeed detrimental to the local economy, to the commuters especially to the urban poor who could only afford to take the conventional vessel, hence, it must be acted upon the earliest possible time so as to maintain the status quo at the Ormoc City port and that business will go on normally;

FOREGOING PREMISES CONSIDERED, on motion of City Councilor Eduardo P. Tan, Chairman, Committee on Transportation & Communications, duly seconded by City Councilor Alfredo F. Capahi; be it

RESOLVED. AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution VEHEMENTLY OPPOSING THE PROPOSED CLOSURE OF THE ORMOC CITY PIER BY THE PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY (PPA) AND THE PROPOSED TRANSFER OF VESSEL DOCKING FROM ORMOC TO PALOMPON, LEYTE PORT;
