


RESOLUTION NO. 99-124

A RESOLUTION OF CONDOLENCE TO THE BEREAVED FAMILY OF THE
LATE RAUL S. MANGLAPUS, FORMER SENATOR AND FOREIGN
AFFAIRS SECRETARY.

WHEREAS, this august Body bears the grief with the passing away of
a statesman, Atty. Raul S. Manglapus who succumbed at the age of 80 on
July 25, 1999;

WHEREAS, the late Raul S. Manglapus, a resident of Alabang,
Muntinlupa City, was the youngest Foreign Minister in the Philippine
History and as a Freedom Loving Man "Raul" as he was fondly called,
founded and became the President of the Movement for a Free Philippines
(MFP) in 1973 and fought for 13 years to restore democracy in the
Philippines;

WHEREAS, Raul Manglapus started his career as appointed
Undersecretary of Foreign Affairs in 1954, Foreign Minister in 1957, and
became the topnotcher senator in 1961. He was elected delegate to the
Constitutional Convention in 1971 and served as the President, Chief
Executive Officer of the Philippine National Oil Company (PNOC) as his
last position as public official;

WHEREAS, the HONORABLE MEMBERS of the EIGHT SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD
ng ORMOC share the intense pain and sorrow with his wife Mrs. PACITA L.
MANGLAPUS and children as well as the anguish and despair with the
passing away of a model family man and an exemplary public servant who
for a good number of years has dedicated the best years of his life in
government service;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, to affix our signatures in this Resolution of Condolence, and be it;


