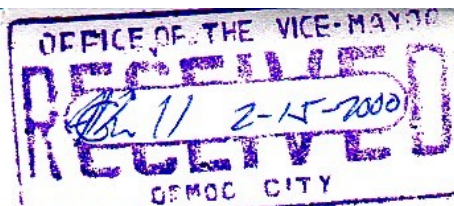
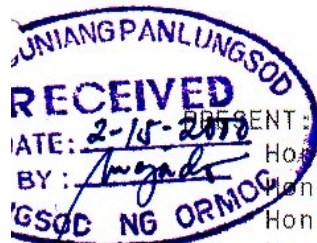

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-022

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE WIDENING AND
EXTENSION OF RC PIER PROJECT (PORT OF ORMOC) AND
RECOMMENDING TO ALL CONCERNED AGENCIES THE NEED FOR THE
TIMELY COMPLETION OF THE SAME.

WHEREAS, sometime last February 1999, the Philippine Ports
Authority (PPA) started the construction of the finger pier for
fastcrafts, and later in July 1999 the widening and extension of the RC
pier with a project cost of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY EIGHT MILLION SIX HUNDRED
EIGHTY SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY THREE PESOS AND 04/100
(P158,686,863.04);

WHEREAS, since then up to the present, except for some minor
inconveniences to commuters, we have not heard, nor noticed any negative
impact caused by the project; neither was there any noticeable negative
impact on the marine life in Ormoc Bay nor to livelihood of fisherfolks
in this area (we hope this continues);

WHEREAS, any delay, however, on this on-going project might turn
this minor inconveniences to some real negative problem; hence, the
request of Mr. Alex T. Cruz, Port Manager, for our support "to ensure
timely completion of the project" deserves our favorable action;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, on motion of City Councilor Jose
C. Alfaro, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Natural Resources and
Environmental Control, jointly seconded by City Councilors Alfredo F.
Capahi and Claudio P. Larrazabal; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution FAVORABLY
ENDORSING THE WIDENING AND EXTENSION OF RC PIER PROJECT (PORT OF ORMOC)
AND RECOMMENDING TO ALL CONCERNED AGENCIES THE NEED FOR THE TIMELY
COMPLETION OF THE SAME;

ADOPTED, February 10, 2000.
