

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-034

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING SENATE BILL NO.
1747, ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROTECTING THE FILIPINO
CHILDREN FROM MALNUTRITION INSTITUTIONALIZING FOR THE
PURPOSE THE MILK FEEDING PROGRAM, APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFORE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES".

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian is in receipt of a copy of Senate Bill No.
1747, introduced by Senator Ramon Magsaysay, Jr., entitled: "AN ACT
PROTECTING THE FILIPINO CHILDREN FROM MALNUTRITION INSTITUTIONALIZING
FOR THE PURPOSE THE MILK FEEDING PROGRAM, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES";

WHEREAS, study shows that 5 out of 10 Filipino children are
suffering from varying degrees of malnutrition based on the nutrition
survey of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) and if
it will remain unchecked, said problem will persist and continue to
worsen;

WHEREAS, Scientific study disclosed that healthy persons need
nutrition food and milk has been identified as one complete and
nutritious food which play a vital role in providing the basic nutrition
to growing children, thus the School Milk Feeding Program, one of the
thrusts of Estrada's Administration was initiated aimed to improve the
nutritional status of children through the National Dairy Authority
(NDA), Department of Agriculture (DA), the Department of Education,
Culture and Sports (DECS) Department of Health (DOH) and the Department
of Social Welfare & Development (DSWD);

WHEREAS, it is for these reasons that Senate Bill No. 1747 was
introduced by Senator Magsaysay Jr., definitely aimed to improve the
health of the young citizens and will stimulate and energize agro-
industry development in the rural areas;

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered on motion of City Councilor Dennis Y. Capuyan, Chairman, Committee on Health duly seconded by City Councilor Mariano Y. Corro; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING SENATE BILL NO. 1747, ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROTECTING THE FILIPINO CHILDREN FROM MALNUTRITION INSTITUTIONALIZING FOR THE PURPOSE THE MILK FEEDING PROGRAM, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES";
