WHERENS, this august Body is in receipt of a letter dated 10 March 2000 from the Honorable City Mayor Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr., addressed the Honorable Members, 8th Sangguniang Panlungsod requesting for passage resolution signifying our interest, willingness and capacity to accept Ormor District Hospital (ODH) if ever it will be turned over by the Province of Leyte to the City of Ormoc:

WYEREAS, it can be recalled that the land where the Ormoc District Hospital (ODH) is located was formerly owned by the City Government of Ormoc to be used as site for the Ormoc District Hospital, formerly Ormoc General Hospital (OGH) which was officially inaugurated on June 29,

WHEREAS, the City Government of Ormoc recognizes the fact that majority of patients served by ODH are constituents of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the financial support extended to ODH by the Provincial Government is inadeguate, thereby resulting to poor quality of health services, poor status of health infrastructures and poor maintenance of equipments

No. 2000-045

to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other services available to all people at affordable cost";
