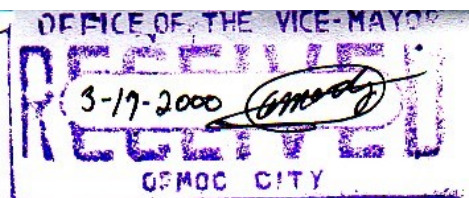

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-045

A RESOLUTION SIGNIFYING INTEREST, WILLINGNESS AND
CAPACITY TO ACCEPT ORMOC DISTRICT HOSPITAL (ODH) IF
EVER IT WILL BE TURNED OVER BY THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE TO
THE CITY OF ORMOC.

WHEREAS, this august Body is in receipt of a letter dated 10 March
2000 from the Honorable City Mayor Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr., addressed
the Honorable Members, 8th Sangguniang Panlungsod requesting for passage
of a resolution signifying our interest, willingness and capacity to
accept Ormoc District Hospital (ODH) if ever it will be turned over by
the Province of Leyte to the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that the land where the Ormoc District
Hospital (ODH) is located was formerly owned by the City Government of
Ormoc to be used as site for the Ormoc District Hospital, formerly Ormoc
General Hospital (OGH) which was officially inaugurated on June 29,
1961;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Ormoc recognizes the fact that
majority of patients served by ODH are constituents of Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, the financial support extended to ODH by the Provincial
Government is inadequate, thereby resulting to poor quality of health
services, poor status of health infrastructures and poor maintenance of
equipment;

WHEREAS, it is in this regard that the City of Ormoc wishes to
assume full administrative control and management of ODH as well as
additional financial support so as to be able to live up to the
expectations of its constituents especially in providing adequate
quality health services to all people at affordable cost, as provided
for in Article XIII Section II of the Philippine Constitution which
provides, "the state shall adopt an integral and comprehensive approach

to health development which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health and other services available to all people at affordable cost";

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of City Councilor Dennis Y. Capuyan, Chairman, Committee on Health, jointly seconded by City Councilors Chiqui B. Labagala and Alfredo F. Capahi; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to pass a resolution SIGNIFYING INTEREST, WILLINGNESS AND CAPACITY TO ACCEPT ORMOC DISTRICT HOSPITAL (ODH) IF EVER IT WILL BE TURNED OVER BY THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE TO THE CITY OF ORMOC;

ADOPTED, March 16, 2000.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution each to His Honor, the Provincial Governor of Leyte, Governor Remedios Petilla; the Regional Director, Department of Health, Tacloban City, the Regional Director of Department of Budget & Management, Tacloban City, His Honor the City Mayor of Ormoc, the City Legal Officer and others concerned, -in Ormoc City;
