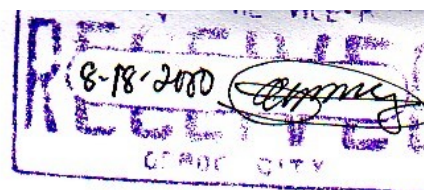
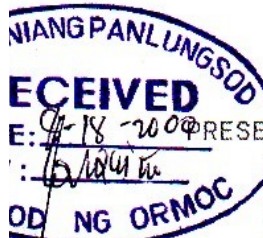

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-135

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE ENACTMENT OF SENATE BILL NO. 2064, INTRODUCED AND SPONSORED BY SENATOR AQUILINO PIMENTEL, JR., CHAIRMAN, SENATE COMMITTEE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, WHICH AMENDS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 (R.A. NO. 7160)

WHEREAS, per newspaper report, specifically The Philippine Daily Inquirer, in its issue of August 8, 2000, Senator Aquilino Pimentel, Jr., Chairman, Senate Committee on Local Governments has introduced and sponsored in the Senate, Senate Bill No. 2064 which will introduce 85 amendments to the present Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments shall include, among others, an increase from 40 percent to 50 percent in local government shares from state taxes, an increase in local government revenues from the utilization of its natural resources from 40 percent to 60 percent, frees local government from state intervention in securing credit financing, allows local governments to appoint their own treasurers, and raises the ceiling of tax scales governing barangay business taxes;

WHEREAS, the proposed amendments to the Local Government Code of 1991, will surely benefit Local Government Units, and further implement the constitutional provisions on the just share in the national taxes, and equitable share in the proceeds of the utilization and development of the national wealth of Local Government (Article X, Sections 6 and 7, of the Philippine Constitution); hence, deserve the wholehearted support and endorsement of Local Government Units;

WHEREFORE, premises considered, on MASS MOTION of the Body; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution SUPPORTING AND ENDORSING THE ENACTMENT OF SENATE BILL NO. 2064, INTRODUCED AND SPONSORED BY SENATOR AQUILINO PIMENTEL, JR., CHAIRMAN, SENATE COMMITTEE ON LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, WHICH AMENDS THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991 (R.A. NO. 7160);


ADOPTED, 17 August 2000.
