

## ESOLUTION NO. 2000-

A RESOLUTION FAVORABLY ENDORSING THE APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION OF TRANS-ASIA SHIPPING LINES, INC., TO OPERATE TYN VESSELS M/V ASIA-INDONESIA, M/V TRANS-ASIA ASIA-BRUNEI AND M/V ASIA-TAIWAN IN THE ROUTE - DRMOC CITY AND VICE VERSA. MANDAUE CITY

WHEREAS, Trans-Asia Shipping Lines, Inc., has filed on 17 May 2000 four (4) separate applications to operate the vessels M/V ASIA-M/V TRANS-ASIA II, M/V ASIA-BRUNEI and M/V ASIA-TAIWAN INDONESIA, through the Cebu Maritime Regional Officer (CMRO) as stated in a copy of ax Inter-Office Memorandum from the Regional Director, Marina VII furnished this Sanggunian, which applications have been strongly opposed by ROBLE SHIPPING, INC., SAN JUAN SHIPPING LINES, INC., ASIAN MARINE TRANSPORT CORP. and CEBU FERRIES CORP., hence this request for consideration:

WHEREAS, said vessels which will be plying the route Mandaue City -Ormoc City and vice versa is another development in the shipping services in Ormoc City which is of great help to commuters, as well as traders, for this will facilitate trade and commerce between Cebu City and the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, M/V San Juan, one of the vessels plying Ormoc-Cebu and vice versa has been sank, thus the need to add a vessel in the same route is imperative;

WHEREAS, this august Body believes that said request 15 meritorious, hence, the same should be given due course of action)

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of Councilor Eduardo P. Tan, Chairman, Committee on Transportation Communications, duly seconded by City Councilor Dennis Y. Capuyan; be i Res. No. 2000-150
