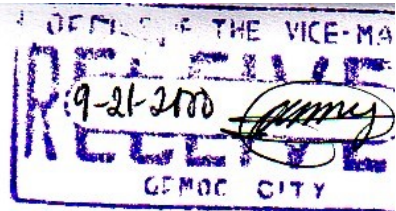
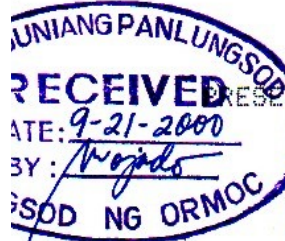

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-168

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY TO
ISSUE A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AGAINST THE UNIVERSAL
TERMINALS INCORPORATED FROM COLLECTING TERMINAL FEE AT
THE ORMOC PORT TERMINAL.

WHEREAS, it has come to the knowledge of this august Body based on
the letter of the Philippine Ports Authority Terminal Supervisor Mr.
Constantino S. Tupa that the passenger terminal at the Port of Ormoc is
already operational and has been operating for sometime now although no
permit to operate has been issued by the Philippine Ports Authority in
favor of the operator Universal Terminals Incorporated;

WHEREAS, there is a willful violation on the part of Universal
Terminals Incorporated on existing rules and regulations of the
Philippine Ports Authority having NO permit to operate;

WHEREAS, from the start of its operation up to the present, said
operator, Universal Terminal Incorporated has been collecting terminal
fee from passengers, which this august Body believes is illegal, for the
reason that said operator, Universal Terminals Incorporated has no
authority whatsoever from the Philippines Ports Authority to operate
said terminal therefore collecting terminal fee is unauthorized, hence,
the same should be stopped;

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of City
Councilor Eduardo P. Tan, Chairman, committee on Transportation and
Communications, severally seconded by City Councilors Dennis Y. Capuyan,
Fe S. Lladoc & Fernando P. Parrilla; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution REQUESTING PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY TO ISSUE A CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AGAINST THE UNIVERSAL TERMINALS INCORPORATED FROM COLLECTING TERMINAL FEE AT THE ORMOC PORT TERMINAL;

ADOPTED, September 20, 2000.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this resolution each to the Administrator, Philippine Ports Authority, Manila, the Honorable City Mayor Eufrocino M. Codilla, Sr., the Terminal Supervisor, PPA, Ormoc City, the Port Manager, Philippine Ports Authority, Tacloban City, the General Manager, Universal Terminals, Inc., Cebu City, the Terminal Manager, Ormoc Port Terminal, the Manager, Universal Aboitiz Inc., Ormoc City and others concerned, -in Ormoc City;
