RESOLUTION NO. 2000-188

AESOLUTION RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, THROUGH ITS CHAIRMAN, HON. CORAZON ALMA G. E LEON, TO EXEMPT ELECTIVE OFFICIALS FROM MANDATORY ANNUAL FIVE-DAY VACATION LEAVE".

WREREAS, existing rules and regulations of the Civil Service Commission require all officials and employees with 10 days or more vacation leave credits to go on vacation leave for a minimum of five (5) working days annually:

WHEREAS, the aforementioned rule has been applied to members of this Sanggunian, that is, they are required to go on a mandatory annual five-day vacation leave;

WHEREAS, Article 172 of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991 (RRILGC), paragraph (a) thereof, in part provides: "X X X. Local Government personnel shall be encouraged to take an annual five (5) days vacation leave if he has at least a total of ten (10) days vacation leave credits earned during the year";

WHEREAS, the aforequoted provision of the RRILGC merely ENCOURAGES the taking of an annual five (5) days vacation leave; hence, not MANDATORY;

WHEREAS, Mrs. Ligaya Gonzaga, Director II, of the Civil Service Commission, Region 08, in a recent dialogue with the officials and employees of the City Government of Ormoc, explained that the aforequoted rule, means that members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod can only be considered ABSENT if he does not attend the sessions of the sanggunian, and the reason why they (elective officials) are not required to keep a daily record of attendance is that they are presumed to be always available to their constituents for consultations;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing observations, elective officials should not be covered by the "mandatory annual five-day vacation leave", otherwise they cannot be of service at all times to their constituents;

WHEREFORE, on motion of City Councilor Mariano Y. Corro, jointly seconded by City Councilors Chiqui B. Labagala and Dennis Y. Capuyan; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution RESPECTFULLY REQUESTING THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION, THROUGH ITS CHAIRMAN, HON. CORAZON ALMA G. DE LEON, TO EXEMPT ELECTIVE OFFICIALS FROM THE "MANDATORY ANNUAL FIVE-DAY VACATION LEAVE";
