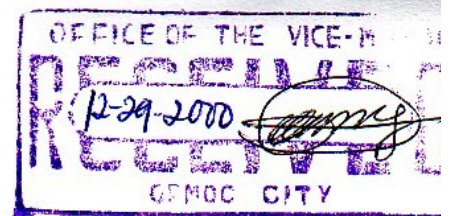
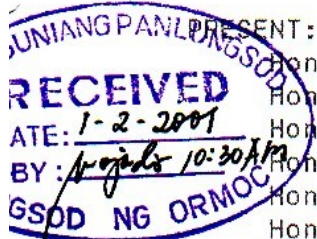

RESOLUTION NO. 2000-228

A RESOLUTION NAMING THE 10 METER ROAD WHICH IS THE MAIN  
ENTRANCE OF THE RESETTLEMENT AREA FOR THOSE AFFECTED BY  
THE JICA FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT AT BARANGAY LAO, ORMOC  
CITY, AS "MAKOTO MIGITA STREET."

WHEREAS, a request has been made regarding the naming of the main  
entrance, a ten (10) meter road at the JICA Resettlement Area after the  
late Mr. Makoto Migita;

WHEREAS, said resettlement area is for those families who are  
affected by the JICA Flood Control Project and are presently staying at  
said area;

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that the late Mr. Makoto Migita was the  
Project Manager of the Consultant, CTI Engineering Co. Ltd.. He was  
assigned as the Team Leader of the Project for Flood Mitigation in Ormoc  
City. He was highly commended as Project Manager at the Implementation  
Stage, who worked honestly and became the instrument for the realization  
of the said projects. Unfortunately, after completing the Contract and  
ground breaking on November 5, 1997, for Phase I of this project, he  
felt ill and was forced to undergo medical check-up. He was  
hospitalized and then passed away on March 3, 1998;

WHEREAS, of significance to state in here is Section 13 par. (b) of  
R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, which  
in part provides:



"(b) The Sanggunian of highly urbanized cities and component cities whose charters prohibit their voters from voting for provincial elective officials, hereinafter referred to in this Code as independent component cities, may in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of the following within its territorial jurisdiction.

(2) City roads, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares, and bridges; (Emphasis Supplied)

The name of a local government unit or a public place, street or structure with historical, cultural or ethnic significance shall not be changed, unless by a unanimous vote of the Sanggunian concerned and in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission (P.H.C.);

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian believes that naming of said ten (10) meter road main entrance at the resettlement area will give significance to the efforts of the late Mr. Makoto Migita;

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of City Councilor Jose C. Alfaro, Jr., Chairman, Committee on Natural Resources & Environmental Control, and Co-Sponsored by City Councilor Nepomuceno P. Aparis I, Chairman, Committee on Laws and Ordinances, jointly seconded by City Councilors Alfredo F. Capahi and Sotero M. Pepito; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to pass a resolution NAMING THE 10 METER ROAD WHICH IS THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF THE RESETTLEMENT AREA FOR THOSE AFFECTED BY THE JICA FLOOD CONTROL PROJECT AT BARANGAY LAO, ORMOC CITY, AS "MAKOTO MIGITA STREET;"

ADOPTED, December 28, 2000.
