

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-012

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CY 2002 ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) IN THE AMOUNT OF NINETY NINE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN THOUSAND PESOS (\$99.367.000.00) PED COO. SEVEN THOUSAND PESOS (#99,367,000.00), PER CDC RESOLUTION NO. 2 S. OF 2001.

WHEREAS, the 9th Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc is in receipt of Indorsement dated 14 December 2001 from the Office of the City Mayor CARMELO endorsing CDC Resolution No. 2 Series of 2001, entitled: "A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CY 2002 ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) IN AMOUNT OF NINETY NINE MILLION THREE HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN THOUSAND PESOS ONLY (\$99,367,000.00) AND REQUESTING THE 9TH HONORABLE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD NG ORMOC FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE SAME;

WHEREAS, said CDC Resolution No. 2 series of 2001 has cited that the City Government of Ormoc has allotted Ninety Nine Million Three Hundred Sixty Seven Thousand Pesos (\$99,367,000.00) for the development projects for the year 2002, to be taken out from 20% Development Fund in the amount of Seventy Eight Million Six Hundred Three Thousand Pesos (\$78,603,000.00) and from the City Engineer's Office in the amount of Twenty Million Seven Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Pesos (\$20,764,000.00);

WHEREAS, CDC Resolution No. 2 Series of 2001 has stated that the following projects are considered eligible for funding, to wit:
