

RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE POLICE REGIONAL OFFICE, CAMP PALO, LEYTE, TO FURNISH SANGGUNIANG KANGLEON, PANLUNGSOD, ORMOC CITY, A FINANCIAL STATEMENT ON HOW MUCH IS BEING ALLOCATED FOR ORMOC CITY PNP.

WHEREAS, the PNP as law enforcers is one of the pillars of criminal justice system endowed with the full power and authority in maintaining peace and order;

WHEREAS, the LGU would like to assess the various PNP stations in Ormoc City and had noted the lack of facilities such as comfort rooms, office equipment, vehicles and other facilities in order to effectively and efficiently carry out its vision, mission and creed;

WHEREAS, the LGU is unaware as to how much is being allocated of its PNP budget to various police field stations particularly and specifically PNP, Ormoc City;

WHEREAS, this should not be misconceived as getting in the way of Regional allocation of PNP funds to its units/stations, but said financial statement would greatly ascertain how much the LGU would extend a helping hand to PNP Ormoc City as a basis for future grant.
