

RESOLUTION NO. 2002-162

PETITIONING THE NATIONAL WATER RESOURCES (NURB) TO DEPUTIZE THE CITY OF ORMOC IN THE GRANTING OF PERMIT TO EXTRACT WATER FROM THE GROUND, LAKES, RIVERS, STREAMS AND OTHER WATER BODIES WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY SO AS TO EFFECTIVELY CHECK, MONITOR, AND REGULATE THE EXTRACTION OF FROM SAID WATER BODIES.

WHEREAS, the major users or suppliers of water in the locality are within the jurisdiction of the City of Ormoc;

WHEREAS, these suppliers provide water to consumers mostly of whom live in urban centers and adjoining barangays of the city comprising a total population of about 154,297 or 21,522 households which comprise some 68% of the total 31,542 households of the city;

WHEREAS, these major users or providers of water utilize pumping units in order to extract water from the ground for their consumers;

WHEREAS, time will come that the amount of extraction from the groundwater will be over that the rain can recharge;

WHEREAS, as a result, water from the aquifer will be seriously depleted and consequently the eater aquifer will be endangered of intrusion by seawater; and,

WHEREAS, there is a need for the City of Ormoc, among others, to monitor and control water extraction by water users or providers from the ground such that rain may be able to recharge the water aquifer;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of City Councilor Jovencio A. Laurente, Vice Chairman, Committee on Environment & Natural Resources, severally seconded by City Councilors Rafael C. Omega, Jr., Gregorio A. Yrastorza, Jr. and Fe S. Lladoc; be it

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to PETITION THE NATIONAL WATER RESOURCES BOARD (NWRB) TO DEPUTIZE THE CITY OF ORMOC IN THE GRANTING OF PERMIT TO EXTRACT WATER FROM THE GROUND, LAKES, RIVERS, STREAMS AND OTHER WATER BODIES WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE CITY SO AS TO EFFECTIVELY CHECK, MONITOR, AND REGULATE THE EXTRACTION OF WATER FROM SAID WATER BODIES;

ADOPTED, June 27, 2002.
