RESOLUTION ENJRINING ALL THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAYS AND COVERAMENT OFFICES IN ORMOC CITY TO REFRAIN FROM MAMING/NEWAMING OF STREETS WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE SAN<mark>GGUNIANG</mark> PANLUNGSOD AND IN CONSULTATION WITH THE MATIONAL MISTORICAL INSTITUTE (NHI).

WMEREAS, it has come to the knowledge of this august Body that some rangays are naming/renaming streets in their respective barangays and Poblacion, City of Ormoc which in turn caused confusion not only to residents but also to the entire Ormoc City as a whole:

WHEREAS, it can be recalled that naming or renaming of streets is provided for in the Local Government Code of 1991 or Republic Act 7160;

WHEREAS, Section 13 Par. (b) thereof provides that:

"(b) The Sanggunians of highly urbanized cities and component cities whose charters prohibit their voters from voting for provincial elective officials, hereinafter referred to in this Code as independent component cities, may in consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission, change the name of the following within its territorial jurisdiction.

(2) City roads, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares and bridges"; (Emphasis Supplied).

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered, on motion of City Councilor Demosthenes F. Tugonon, Chairman, Committee on Ways and Means, duly seconded by City Councilors Rafael C. Omega, $\Im r$. and Ruvinieu E. Mendola; be it

RESOLVED. AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED. to pass a resolution ENJOINING ALL THE SANGGUNIANG BARANGAYS AND CITY GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN ORMOC CITY TO REFRAIN FROM NAMING/RENAMING OF STREETS WITHOUT THE APPROVAL OF THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD AND IN CONSULTATION WITH THE NATIONAL HISTORICAL INSTITUTE (NHI);
