A RESOLUTION INTERPOSING NO OBJECTION ON THE PROPOSED
ESTABLISHMENT OF A GASOLINE SERVICE STATION (CALTEX
SERVICE STATION) OWNED BY ORMOC BAY RESOURCES
CORPORATION, LOCATED AT BARANGAY COGON, THIS CITY.

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian is in receipt of a letter dated 12 August
2002 from Mr. Ernesto B. Rizarri, Project Proponent, requesting for a
Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution interposing no objection on the
proposed establishment of a gasoline service station (Caltex Service
Station) located at Lilia Ave., Brgy. Cogon, this city;

WHEREAS, per 4th Indorsement dated 04 September 2002 from the
Office of the City Mayor, the latter recommends the passage of the
requested resolution and endorses the proposed establishment subject to
the compliance of pertinent rules and regulations in establishing a
gasoline station;

WHEREAS, the Supervising Environmental Management Specialist, Engr.
Juliana P. Flores of the Environment and Natural Resources Division,
City Mayor's Office, recommends for the indorsement of said project
based on the Initial Environmental Examination submitted by the
proponent;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc through the Honorable
Chairman, Committee on Natural Resources & Environmental Control has
considered said request valid and reasonable as a condition precedent to
the issuance of an Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) hence,
