(OCSAT) IN THE MERGER OF VOCATIONAL TECHNICAL SCHOOLS
IN NORTHWESTERN LEYTE AREA TO FORM PART OF THE PROPOSED
VISAYAS MARITIME STATE UNIVERSITY.

WHEREAS, this august Body passed Sangguniang Panlungsod Resolution
No. 2003-037 dated 06 March 2003 entitled: "A RESOLUTION STRONGLY




