

at present the port of Ormoc is becoming one of the busy WHEREAS, ports in the Visayas considering that it serves as a jump-off point to passengers bound for the neighboring visayan islands and to Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, as precautionary measure, it would be proper that a pedestrian lane be established in the said port to avoid accidents to happen especially to passengers;

WHEREAS, it can be recalled, that a male passenger was hit by a cargo truck sometime February of this year and it could have been prevented if a pedestrian lane was established;

WHEREAS, the said project can enhance orderliness at the said port and provide commuters a safer passage way whenever they come in and leave the port area;
