CAMP DOWNES WITH A TOTAL AREA OF 12 HECTARES; 10 HECTARES AS FISH SANCTUARY AND THE REST IS MARINE RESERVED AREA.

WHEREAS, this Sanggunian is in receipt of Barangay Ordinance No. 003, Series of 2003 from the Barangay Council of Barangay Camp Downes, this city, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE COASTAL WATERS OF BRGY.
