WHEREAS, the Sanggunian Panlungsod ng Ormoc passed Resolution No. 2003-227 dated 11 December 2003 entitled; "A RESOLUTION INQUIRING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT SECRETARY, HONORABLE JOSE D.
