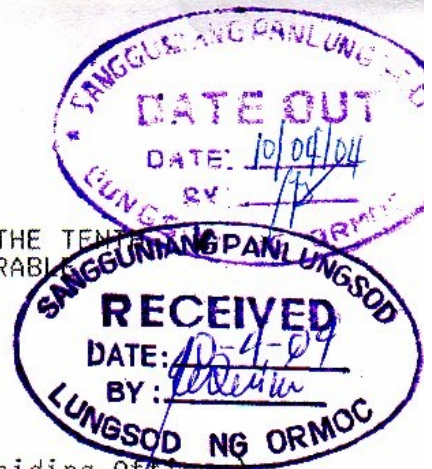

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-078

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR ERIC C.
CODILLA TO ORGANIZE A TASK FORCE OF ELECTRICAL
ENGINEERS AND FIREMEN THAT WILL CONDUCT INSPECTION ON
ALL GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS IN THE CITY OF ORMOC
CONSTRUCTED 20 YEARS AGO OR MORE.

WHEREAS, a fire broke out at the Ormoc City Public Market at dawn
on September 20, 2004 burning down entirely the rice & dry goods
buildings;

WHEREAS, this incident could have been prevented if the occupants
of these stalls were fire conscious and have exercised diligence in the
maintenance of their respective stalls;

WHEREAS, as what has been observed, government buildings such as
these, have been abused by their respective dwellers by tapping or
making illegal wiring connections to accommodate more appliances to the
extent of overloading the main electrical line of these establishments
thereby making it fire hazard;

WHEREAS, this is the problem that the City Government of Ormoc
would like to prevent especially those buildings which are already more
than twenty years in existence, hence, the need for a task force to
conduct the necessary inspection and make recommendations for the
welfare of the public;

WHEREFORE, foregoing premises considered on motion of City
Councilor Sotero M. Pepito, Vice Chairman, Committee on Police, Fire &
Public Safety, duly seconded by City Councilor Mariano Y. Corro; be it
