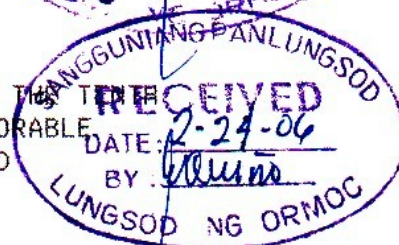
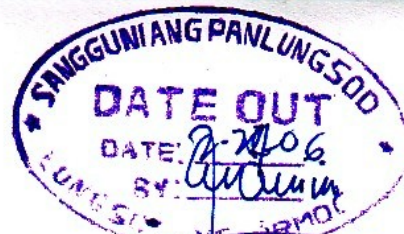

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-035

A RESOLUTION URGING THE CITY TREASURER OF ORMOC TO  
INTENSIFY THE COLLECTION OF LOCAL TAXES ESPECIFICALLY  
FROM PHILIPPINE PORTS AUTHORITY (PPA) AND LEYECO V  
ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE (LEYECO V) IN CONFORMITY WITH, AND  
IN STRICT OBSERVANCE TO, THE PROVISIONS OF THE LOCAL  
GOVERNMENT CODE IN THE COLLECTION OF TAXES, AND TO  
INFORM THIS SANGGUNIANG ON THE ACTION TAKEN THEREON  
WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS FROM RECEIPT OF THIS  
RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the collection of local taxes is the responsibility of the  
City Treasurer as mandated by the provisions of the Local Government  
Code of 1991 (RA 7160), specifically Section 170 thereof;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court in its decision is G.R. No. 143214, Nov.  
11, 2004, entitled: "Philippine Ports Authority vs. the City of Iloilo,  
et al." has ruled that Philippine Ports Authority is liable for the  
payment of taxes on its facilities to the local government;

WHEREAS, on the May 3, 2005 issue of the Philippine Daily Inquirer,  
appeared the news item, that the City Government of Tacloban "will  
finally receive some ₱26 million in franchise tax from the Leyte II  
Electric Cooperative (LEYECO II);

WHEREAS, the City Government of Ormoc should strive to collect  
local taxes due the LGU (like the real property tax from GAISANO), so  
that the City will not be wholly dependent on its Internal Revenue  
Allotment (IRA) in financing its operations;
